In addition Leslie is on the board of Overseers for the New York University Faculty of Arts and Sciences and is the Chairman of the New York University Science Advisory Board.

Leslie is also currently a Lecturer at Stanford Graduate School of Business where he teaches courses in entrepreneurship and sales organization.

At Wall Street Systems, Leslie will take an active role in working with the executive management team to develop the company's long term growth strategy, and will advise on commercial tactics. "I'm looking forward to putting my experience of building successful high-tech businesses to good use in my new role at Wall Street Systems," said Mark Leslie, new non-executive board member and chairman of the Executive Committee. "It's a dynamic company with great prospects ahead of it, as it extends its market leadership."
